Rules for U5 and U6 “4 vs. 4”

1. Players in U5 and U6 categories: born in 2005 and 2004
(Passport or registration certificate from your RSA).
2. Field size: 40 m x 20 m (131.3' x 65.6').
3. Goal size: Small handball goals.
4. A team is comprised of at most 10 players and 2 coaches. At least one of the coaches must have a coach passport.
5. No coach will be allowed behind the goal or on the field during the games.
6. There will be no goalkeeper.
7. Two halves of 15 minutes.
8. Player substitutions every 3 minutes.
9. All penalties will lead to an indirect free kick. (The young players do not commit fouls voluntarily. The indirect free kick encourages passes and cooperation among players.)
10. Distance of 3 meters on throw-ins (Goal line kick, corner kick, free kick and throw-in).
11. For U5 and U6 categories player, throw-in is kick only.
12. After a goal: throw-in on the center spot.
13. Since the field is smaller than usual, the ball may go out of bounds frequently. Encourage the parents to become ballpersons, so the game will run smoother.
14. Every player will receive a participation medal.
15. City of Granby By-law on the Banning of Dogs in Municipal Parks.

205. Nuisances

Occurrence constituting a nuisance:

g) any dog, stray or not, found to be, on a leash or not, accompanied by his owner or not, in a park, a playground or a public building in the sense of the Law with regard to Security in Public Buildings (L.R.Q., c.S-3) without the express consent of the owner, the tenant or the occupant of the land, with the exception of a dog park, as detailed in Annex “10”, and with exception to the “Terres Miner” park, as detailed in Annex “10.1”, within the conditions as outlined in the present by-law, the said annexes are an integral part of the present by-law.

206. Infraction

The owner, of a dog considered to be a nuisance, is considered to have committed an infraction to the present by-law.

207. Guide-Dog Exceptions

- Paragraphs d) to g) of Article 205 do not apply to sight-impaired individual's guide-dogs, provided that the dog is equipped with the appropriate guide-dog harness.
